Where Do You Work?

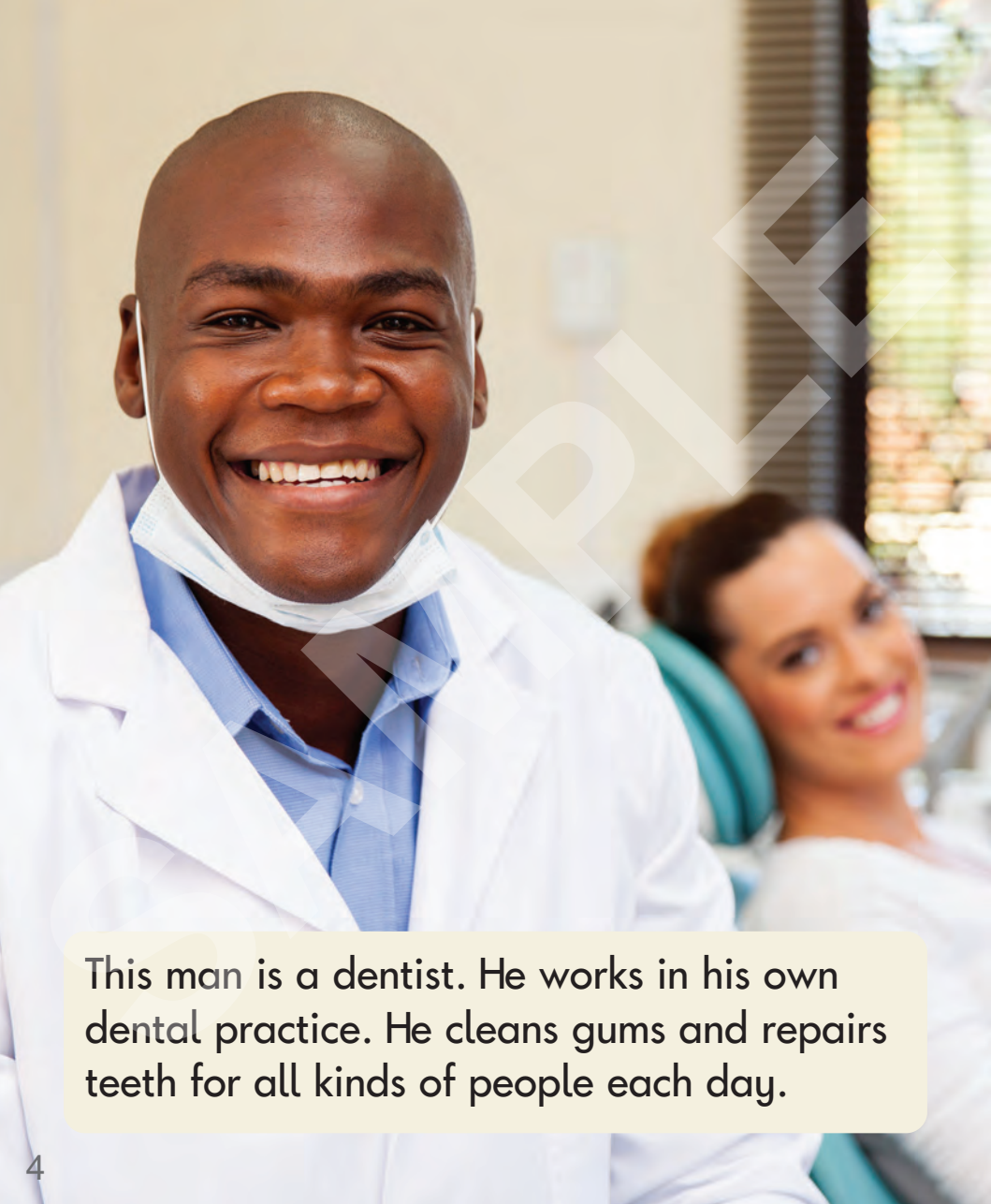




Do you often wonder where some people work and what they do for their jobs?



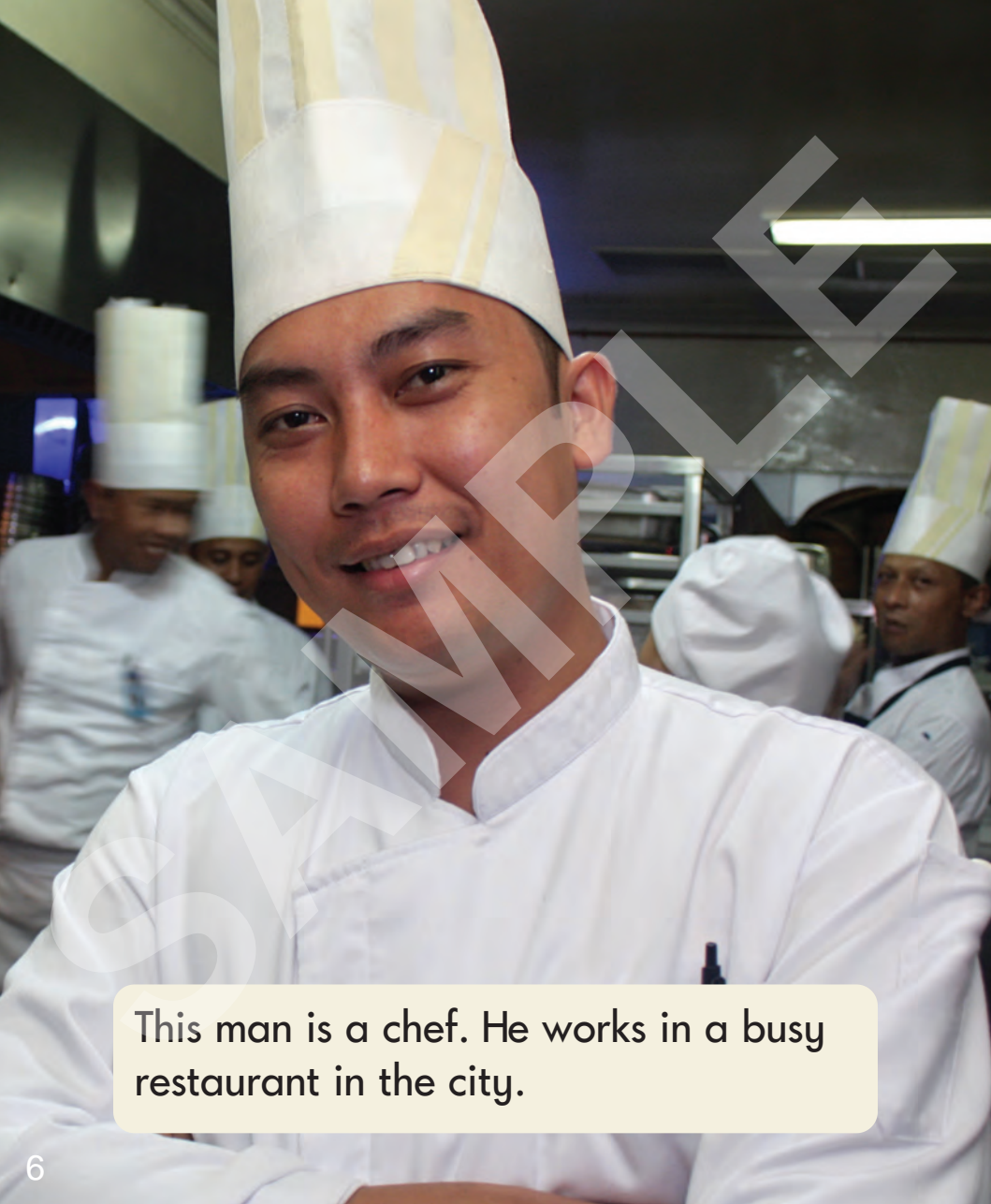
This lady is a doctor. She works in a hospital treating patients. She leads a medical team.



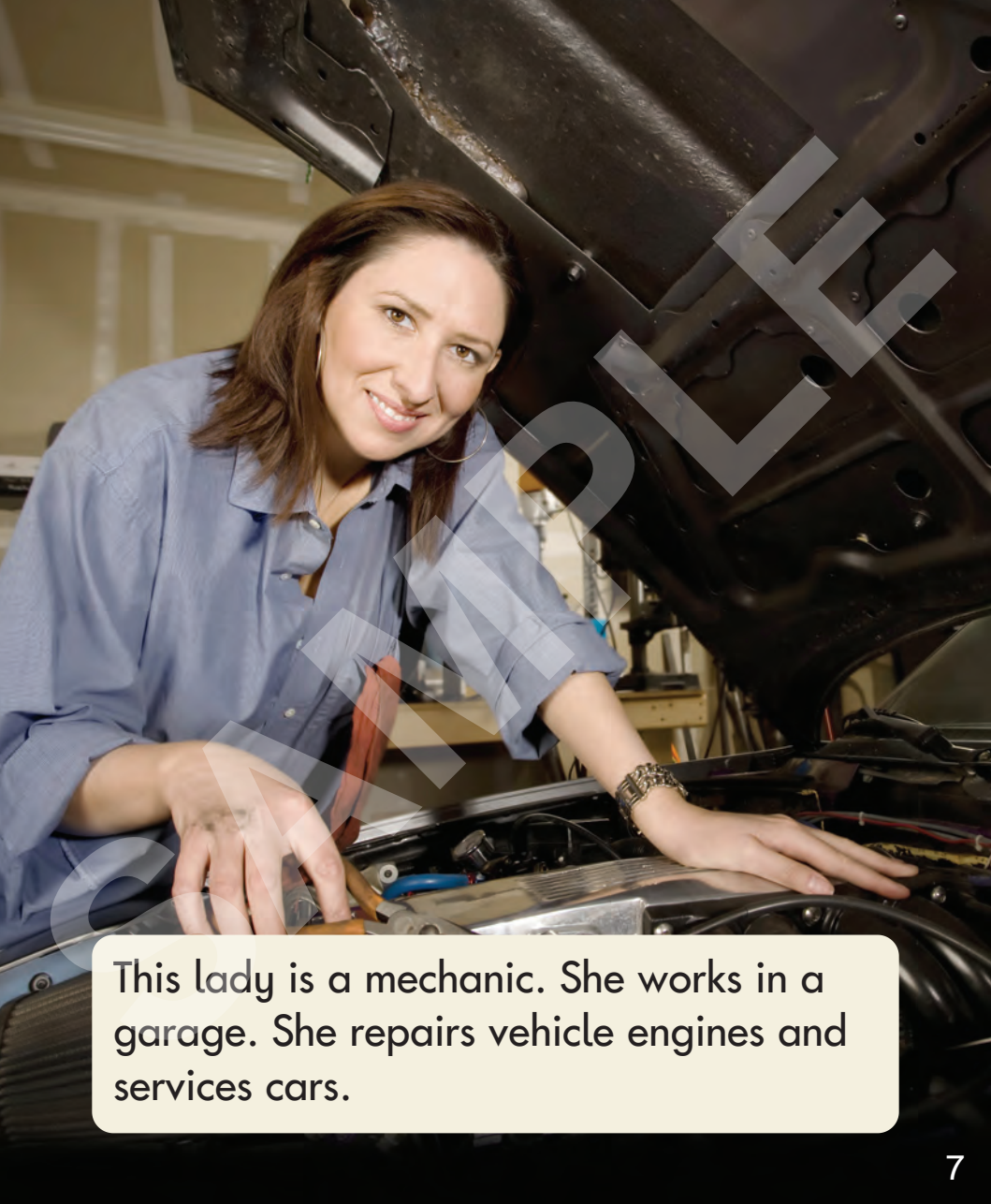
This man is a dentist. He works in his own dental practice. He cleans gums and repairs teeth for all kinds of people each day.



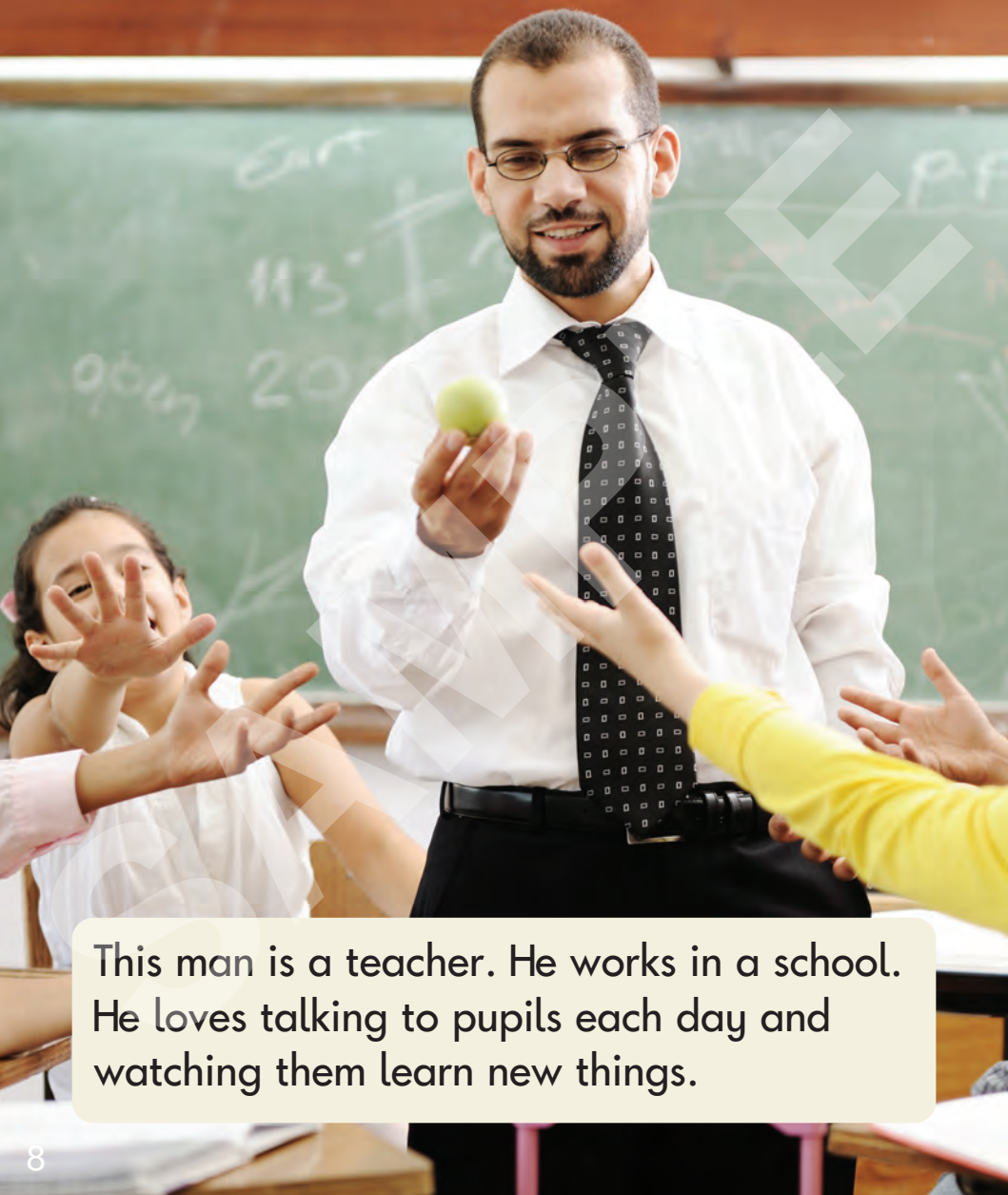
This lady is a clothes shop assistant. She works in a fashion store. She helps customers fit and choose clothes to buy.
